

Welcome to the Monthly Tracker Report for Scotland's Housing First Pathfinder Programme

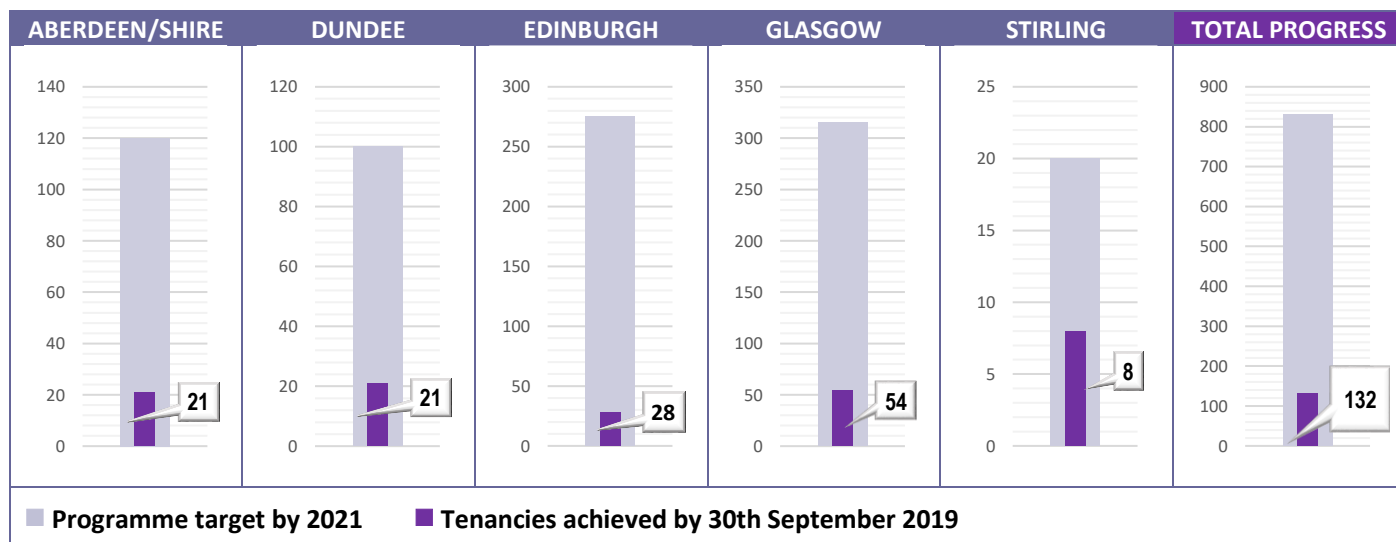
830 Housing First tenancies will be provided for people in Aberdeen City, Aberdeenshire, Dundee, Edinburgh, Glasgow and Stirling by March 2021. The quarterly guidance targets below accumulate to reach this total within timescale. Progress toward those targets at 30th September 2019 is shown below:

KEY POINTS

- The number of new Housing First tenancies started during September 2019 was **14**, bringing the total for the Programme to **132**.
- **126*** people continue to sustain their tenancies, which is **95%** of the tenancies started. During September **1** tenancy ended as a result of a long-term prison sentence, bringing the total number of ended tenancies to **6** where the person hasn't moved directly into another secure tenancy.
- For tenancies beginning in September 2019 the average length of time before moving in was **63** days; the average time for the Programme to date is **84** days.
- **No tenancies** have ended so far as a result of eviction or abandonment.

* The numbers in the tracker have been revised in line with updated local reporting.
